



Vero National Marine Electronic Certificate Issuing System (E-Cert)

What does E-Cert do?

- Allows clients to create their own import or export certificates electronically via the Internet 24/7.
- Automatically produces their declaration
- Allows cloning of previous similar shipment details and storage of commonly used information,
- With inbuilt emailing facility to banks and customers to speed up transaction times.

Who can use E-Cert?

E-Cert is available to all our clients who need to issue Import or Export Certificates. All the client needs is a PC, access to the Internet and a Login I/D and password from Vero National Marine.

How easy is E-Cert to use?

Anyone who can fill in a Certificate manually will be able to use E-Cert. We will provide full training and there is also an extensive on-line help system. Of course, Vero National Marine staff are always available to help.

Why should a client use E-Cert?

E-Cert is a flexible system which

- saves time and money.
- is a multi currency system
- allows the client to enter special conditions to meet bank or others requirements
- can be produced with multiple copies.

How does a client get set-up on E-Cert?

Simply contact your local Vero National Marine Branch. They will set-up the coverage conditions (as per the Policy). With up to ten different certificate layouts and a further ten sets of conditions per layout, customers with multiple commodities and special conditions can be rapidly set up.

User Login I/D and password will be provided to the client, then it is simply a matter of logging onto the Vero National Marine web site and selecting 'Electronic Certificates' from the 'Products' menu.

Once the client enters their User Name and Password they can begin to enter the details of a new certificate. Also from this point they can search for a previous certificate, view all certificates and access Reports or on-line Help.

Where does the client get the information from to fill in the Certificate?

Policy information is pre-set by Vero National Marine. The remainder of the information comes from the shipping order, bill of lading and letter of credit.

The current list of Vero National Marine Surveyors and Agents is automatically updated on the system. Simply select the country of destination, a list of agents for that country is displayed, select the appropriate choice and all addresses etc automatically populate the certificate.

What happens to the Certificate once it has been produced on E-Cert?

A Certificate is initially produced as a draft which can then be sent to a third party by e-mail from within the system eg: to the Bank, for checking before it is issued. This gives the client control and minimises errors.

A draft Certificate can easily be edited but once a Certificate has been issued (Status Final) it can not be changed.

Once the Certificate is finalised, the client can print it or email it to the appropriate party.

When is the E-Cert System available?

E-Cert is available now. It has been trialed live over the past three months and has been successfully used by many of our existing clients, including those with overseas subsidiaries.
